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I made changes to wage rules that are not reflected on my reports – Why?

Wage calculations in Labor are triggered by various saved and/or posted transactions. In addition, wage calculations run on an interval basis. If you make changes to a rule and need Labor to re-calculate immediately, use the **Recalculate Wage Details** utility.

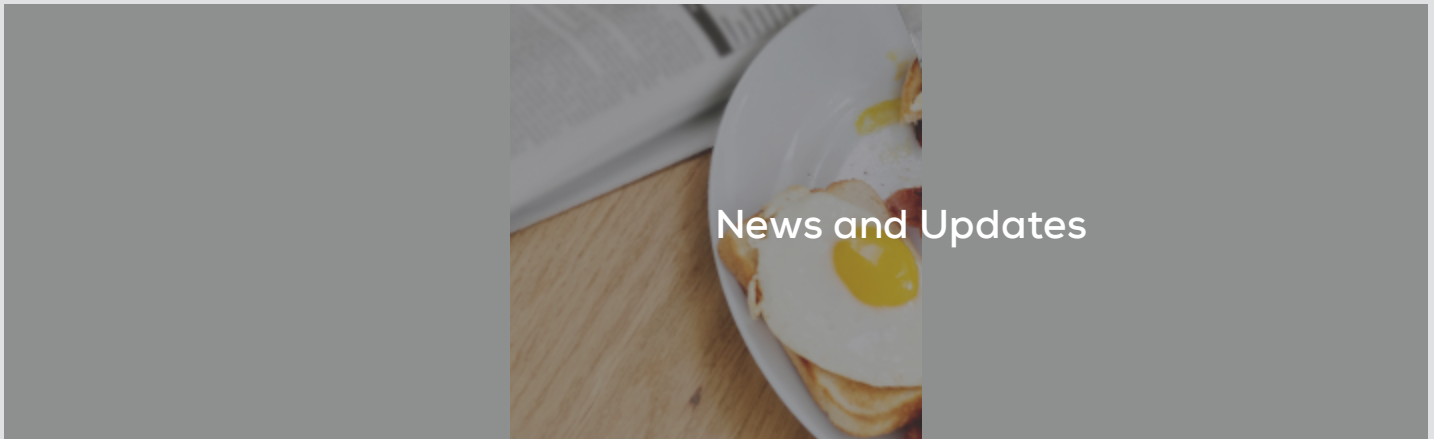
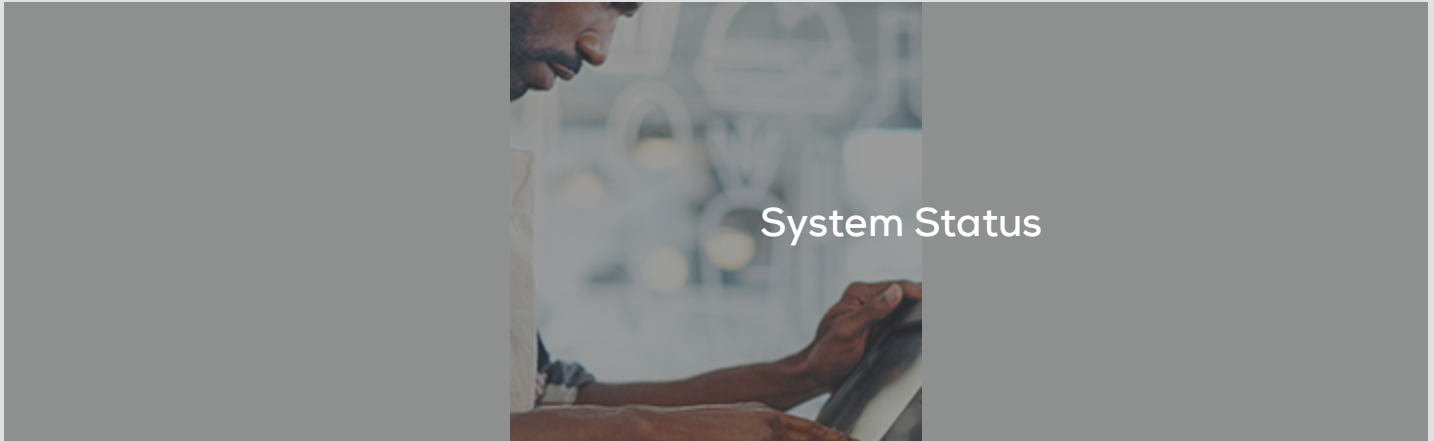
